










Community workshop on standards and infrastructure for predicted effector gene lists



What: A community workshop to discuss standards, infrastructure, and incentives to promote sharing and interoperability of predicted effector gene (PEG) lists, hosted by the Knowledge Portal Network and the GWAS Catalog.

Why: Lists of the genes that are predicted to be effectors (causal genes) are a valuable outcome of GWAS, but the proliferation of multiple evidence types, methods, and presentation format carries the risk of confusion.
